1. Processing / Storage / Retrieval and Disclosure of Health Data

The processing of your personal data is carried out for the purpose of fulfilling the treatment contract (art. 6 par.1 lit. b) GDPR). To ensure optimal medical care, we may request and store previous medical images and findings. The disclosure of your health data is strictly purpose-bound and only occurs when necessary for your medical treatment (art. 9 par. 2 lit. h) GDPR).

This includes medical practices / accident insurance providers / clinical institutes and hospitals.

Categories of other potential recipients: laboratory and billing service providers, statutory / private health insurance companies, and pension insurance providers, where required for billing or reimbursement purposes.

Automated decision-making / profiling: No automated decision-making takes place including profiling as defined in art. 22 GDPR.

2. Appointment Management with Doctolib

To manage appointments, **Berliner Radiologie** uses the appointment booking system of Doctolib GmbH (Mehringdamm 51, 10961 Berlin). Doctolib processes your data as a data processor on behalf of the practice (art. 28 GDPR).

The stored data includes:

- Last name / First name / Date of birth / Address / Phone number / Email address / Health insurance status
- Referring practice / Reason for visit / Appointment history

For booked appointments, you may receive reminders via SMS and/or email.

3. Use of the Telematics Infrastructure (TI)

Our practice uses the telematics infrastructure (TI) for the secure processing of medical data in accordance with the GDPR and the German Social Code Book V (SGB V).

You may object to the use of the electronic patient record (ePA) at any time by notifying your health insurance provider.

4. Retention Period

Data is retained for 10 years in accordance with legal requirements (§ 630f BGB). X-ray images of adult patients taken for diagnostic purposes must be retained for 10 years in accordance with § 85 (2) StrlSchG. Additionally, the archiving obligations of accident insurance carriers apply.

5. Your Rights and Right of Revocation

You are entitled to access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, data portability, and have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority Berliner Beauftragte für Datenschutz und Informationsfreiheit, (art.12-23 GDPR), Alt-Moabit 59–61, 10555 Berlin.

You are entitled to withdraw any consent you have expressed for use your data at any time with future effect (art.7 (3) GDPR). The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out up to the time of withdrawal.

Processing based on legitimate interests:

If we process your data to protect legitimate interests (e.g., IT security, legal claims), you may object to such processing at any time on grounds relating to your particular situation (art. 21 GDPR).

Obligation to provide data:

The provision of your health data is legally and contractually required for the performance of the treatment. Without this information, treatment may not be possible or may be limited. All other information is voluntary.
